### Remember:

Objective observations describe facts (what was seen/heard). Subjective observations describe opinions (feelings, impressions, interpretations).

# Fact or Opinion?

### **Observation Notes**

### **Objective Observations:**

- "Sasha smiled"
- "Used a fisted grip to hold"
- "Crayon in her left hand"
- "Held the paper in place with two hands"
- "Spent 20 minutes at the art table"

### Subjective Observations to Avoid:

• "They were happy"



# Observation Notes

### **Objective Observations:**

- "Mia selected two plastic carrots"
- "She counted out loud"
- "Pushed each carrot...with her left hand saying, "one, two"
- "She smiled and looked up"

### Subjective Observations to Avoid:

- "Carefully"
- "She was pleased"


### **Observation Notes**

- "He put 26 upper case letter of the alphabet in order"
- "He named each letter correctly"
- "He clapped his hands and said 'I did it'"

### Subjective Observations to avoid:

• "He was proud"

- "...rings the bell to transition"
- "She covers her ears"

### Subjective Obeservation to Avoid:

• "Tamika hates"
