

Family Albums, Scrapbooks, or Storybooks

Use these ideas to create a Family Album activity for the children in your program. Consider the ages and skills of the children and modify the template and instructions to meet the needs of individual children and families. Feel free to add or remove pages or change the headings.

Be creative and guide the children to design an album that represents what is important to them and their family.

TIPS TO REMEMBER:

- Every family is unique. Respect the similarities and differences among them.
- Include items that:
 - o Are especially meaningful to the child and his/her family
 - Show a family's history
 - Tell a story about a child's family
 - o Connect with a family's culture or background
 - Preserve a memory for the future

Items may include: notes, letters, postcards, greeting cards, ticket stubs, invitations, announcements, certificates, awards, ribbons, children's handprints/footprints, pieces of fabric, and more. Actual items can be replaced with photographs, drawings, or written descriptions.

- Families are critical partners in children's development and learning. Communicate instructions clearly so family members and children can participate actively and successfully this activity.
- Family stories can be record in many ways such as: videos, audio files, paintings/ drawings, poems, song, story panels, collages of pictures and words.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Download the Family Album template or create your own template for children to use with their family members.
- 2. Explain the activity to families and how albums and scrapbooks will be shared with others (see sample instructions for families). Feel free to translate instructions into the languages children in your program speak at home.
